▪ North:

Pauline said Greg had little success either – too often it just doesn't get to the appropriate person.

Rosie would like to ask everyone to do a visiting artists talk at one sharing session a year. Does not have to be famous.

Jeanette Rengel ran a PD that attracted a number of the Central people like Karen Sabitay. Pauline felt it was unusual that they travelled out so far rather than attend Morley as the designated central location.

Carrissa Russell will take over Morley area – we can call it North East.
