

ARTED Sub Committee Descriptors

Are you wondering if you might be able to help out on one of the Sub Committees mentioned / described below? All volunteers are accepted. Think about the expertise you may have or maybe just an area of interest to which you can give some extra time.

Communications / Publications Sub Committee

(Incorporates production, marketing, distribution of Journal; Arts Still Alive; Webpage; yahoo discussion list)

This sub committee covers a lot of territory from *digital communication* via the yahoo list and publications such as the website, to *hard copy products* such as the Journal and Arts Still Alive style publication. An enthusiastic Primary sub committee is very keen to create a new look and rebadged version of an Arts Still Alive style publication.

Membership Sub Committee

(includes promoting ArtEd at various venues/events; approaching sponsors; maintain membership register)

Are you good at asking for things such as discounts, sponsorship? We only have five sponsors offering discounts at the moment! Are you good at making new people feel welcome? Or interested in developing partnerships with like minded groups? Maybe in promoting ArtED to a wider audience? Or making sure that members are actually getting what they want? It is all part of supporting the membership registrar who manages all of the paper work involved in keeping a current membership database.

Professional Learning Sub Committee

Providing professional learning opportunities has become an increasingly important part of our association. There are already some great PD opportunities lined up, but it will need people to help make them all happen. The more on the Sub committee, the smaller the load as its members share out the organisation and management on the day of PDs. (includes sourcing artists / PD providers and suitable venues; setting a price and max. number of participants; managing advertising and RSVP sign up; running the day - certificates of participation, receipts; maintaining register of attendances for legal purposes i.e. tax and WACOT; report for the website;

Events Sub Committee

This might be anything from organising the windup to hosting a general meeting or maybe planning a social event on the holidays that will enable country members to connect with their colleagues. 2010 also means it is time for the First Love Exhibition again - so if you enjoy social connections or are interested in having an opportunity to sell your art work, then you may well be interested in becoming involved in this sub committee.

Primary Network Sub Committee

This has been a tremendous example of how successfully a small group can work to meet the needs of its Primary members through networks and Primary specific PD throughout the entire metro region and just a tiny bit into country regions through some online connections. (includes all 4 regional networks N; S; Hills; Central and Country if interested)

Secondary Network Sub Committee(Networking re specific secondary issues)

There is an appetite to develop something similar to the way the Primary sub committee works it just needs a few people to make it a starter! Might you be one to help out here?

Tertiary Sub Committee

Maybe this needs to be a group that focuses on the specific needs of our tertiary student members and their teachers/lecturers ie how best to support our graduate students at Uni. and through mentoring in those first few years out? NB: Opportunities to set yourself up for addressing Level 3 competencies here - as there is for all of the other sub committees.

Constitution Sub Committee

Unfortunately we didn't get the rewrite finalised in 2009, but a good start has been made - anyone with a long term interest in what ArtED stands for and how it should be best organised to meet the needs of its members - this may well be the spot for you to do your bit.
